

Event Committee Members

Event committee is responsible for coordinating a variety of events throughout the year including, but not limited to, social events, specialty camps/seminars, and club-sponsored classes. Members of the committee will work closely with the Greeley Ice Haus and other MVSC committees to coordinate and fund activities and events. Events will be expected to be scheduled and on the calendar approximately 6-12 months in advance. Meetings will be held once a month, either virtually or in person, for project updates from each committee member.

Chair – Responsible for planning *minimum* of two (2) specialty camps or seminars per membership year. Will also work closely with the co-chair to plan consistent club-sponsored classes. If desired, planning camp-specific fundraisers or working with the fundraising committee to help fund camps/classes. Responsible for all marketing campaigns for camps and/or fundraisers for camps/classes.

- Time commitment – approximately 3-4 hours/month, or as needed to fulfill commitment

Co-Chair – Responsible for planning club sponsored classes throughout the year, focused in areas distinct from classes offered by the Greeley Ice Haus. Based on current offerings from the Ice Haus, these classes can include ballet, choreography, ice dance, synchro, pairs, spins, jumps, moves in the field, theater on ice, or other. A *minimum* of two (2) classes per month for a duration of thirty (30) minutes each will be required. Classes can rotate through topics and/or coaches but should be offered for a duration long enough that skaters can become competent in a new skill. Responsible for marketing of classes.

- Time commitment – approximately 2-3 hours/month, or as needed to fulfill commitment

Member #1 – Will be responsible for planning a *minimum* of two (2) social events throughout the year. This will include the Awards Banquet in October plus another event chosen by member in April - June. Will be responsible for working with the Board for an event budget. If needed, work with fundraising committee to fundraise for events. Responsible for marketing of events.

- Time commitment – 1-3 hours/month, depending on event

Member #2 – Will be responsible for planning a *minimum* of two (2) social events throughout the year. This will include the annual bowling party in August plus another event chosen by member in January - March. Will be responsible for working with the Board for an event budget. If needed, work with fundraising committee to fundraise for events. Responsible for marketing of events.

- Time commitment – 1-3 hours/month, depending on event
