

Performance Committee Members

Performance Committee is responsible for planning and executing performances for the club multiple times per year. This can include, but is not limited to, showcases, exhibitions, theatrical shows, recitals, or co-sponsoring the Winter Show with the Ice Haus. The Committee will also be responsible for scheduling practices and performances for the Performance Team. Monthly update meeting can be planned as online or in-person meeting.

Chair – Will work closely with the Ice Haus to co-sponsor the Winter Show. Responsible for providing monthly updates on club performances to the Board of Directors at their regularly scheduled meetings. Assist each member as needed.

- Time commitment – Variable based on involvement and complexity of show and help other committee members may need.

Co-Chair – Responsible for planning a minimum of one show per calendar year. All efforts should be made to make it unique to other performances done in the calendar year. Find and plan performances for the Performance Team. This can include hockey game intermission performances and promotional exhibitions during special events at the Ice Haus.
