2024-2025 Season

- The season will run August 2024 April 2025.
- First practice will be August 7th @ 4:45-5:15
- Parent Meeting is June 12th @ 5:30pm at the Ice Haus
- Performances will primarily occur during hockey season, but we will also be looking at competitions to compete
 in.

Performance Team Requirements:

- Completed Basic 4 Skills (Learn to Skate).
- Attend team practices on Wednesdays 4:45 pm 5:15 pm at the Greeley Ice Haus.
- Purchase at least one costume for performances.
- Participate in a *minimum* of ONE fundraising event.

Attendance Policy and Communication

- Attendance is CRUCIAL for a successful team! Skaters cannot gracefully change their routine on the fly because someone does not show up to a performance, nor does it facilitate a productive practice when the coach has to re-choreograph routines every week because people are absent.
- We will be learning 3-4 routines for this season within the first 2 months (August-September) **NO ABSENCES ARE ALLOWED DURING THIS TIME!!**
- Each skater is permitted 2 "excused absences" each semester to allow for illness & travel flexibility. Excused absences are absences that have been communicated to the Performance Chair **PRIOR TO** the start of practice.
- Unexcused absences will not be tolerated. When we don't know ahead of time a skater's inability to attend
 practice/performance, it is detrimental to the entire team. Excessive absences will result in a review from the
 committee and will result in penalties up to being removed from the team.
- Examples of missing more than one practice. If your Skater has an excused absence and then needs another one, the Skater will not be able to perform whichever routine is being practiced at that time due to the couch having to choreograph it.
- Illness absence consequences will be up to the Coaches discretion.
- Skaters that quit before the season is over will be DISQUALIFIED from joining the team the following season.
